Examination Information:

If your child does not have an exam, please arrange a place for them off campus as we do not provide supervision for students, at school, during exam times. After your child has completed their exam, please arrange for them to leave campus shortly thereafter. Bring two pencils (HB) and two pens to every exam. Make sure you arrive 15 minutes early for provincial exams so that you can sign in at the door and receive your booklet.

Examination Rules:

- 1. Disqualification** from the examination will result if you bring books, paper, notes or unauthorized electronic devices into **the examination room**.
- Exams are designed to be completed in two hours. *Students may, however, take up to 60 minutes of additional time to finish.*
- No food or drink is allowed in the examination.
- Candidates should be in their appointed seats at least **ten minutes** before the examination starting time.
- Candidates are not permitted to leave the examination room until one hour after the examination has started.
- Any candidate who leaves the examination room is not permitted to return for the duration of the examination. However, in special circumstances, such as illness, candidates are allowed to leave the examination room temporarily, but only under supervision.
- Any candidate who is over thirty minutes late for an examination will not be permitted to enter the examination room.
- Any candidate who is late for an examination is not allowed to make up the missed time at the end of the examination session.
- Candidates must not give or receive assistance of any kind in answering an examination question during an examination, including allowing one's paper to be viewed by others or copying answers from another student's paper.
- Candidates must not possess any book, paper or item that might assist in writing an examination, including a dictionary or piece of electronic equipment that is not specifically authorized for the examination by the instructor.
- Candidates must immediately follow the invigilator's order to stop writing at the end of the examination time and must not alter an examination booklet or response form after the invigilator has asked students to hand in examination papers.
- Candidates must not communicate with another student during an examination.
- Candidates must not remove any piece of the examination materials from the examination room, including work pages.
- At the end of the examination, return the student booklet and the response form (if required) to the supervisor.
- Students may not go to the washroom during the exam. Please go to the bathroom before the exam begins.
