Middle/High School Admissions Policy

Cedars Christian Middle and High School provides enrolment opportunities to families with children who are in need of ESL. The school will consider International students if they have a local home environment that understands and is supportive of the school's program.

CCS will enrol up to two ESL students per homeroom class provided all regular conditions of enrolment are met.

The school determines the number of ESL hours of instruction the student may need.

ESL students need to meet the academic goals of Grade 10 before entry into Grades 11 and 12.

Students must live with parents or a parent before Grade 9. The school reserves the right to determine the family with whom the student will stay. No student will be permitted to live in a suite or live on their own since not only is he/she in Canada to study but also to integrate into Canadian society and culture. If a student is living with someone other than their parent/parents, the coordinator will need to interview the family and ensure that the home stay environment is consistent with the school's vision and enrolment policies.
